It's time to start thinking about Men's Basketball. Get your team together, hit the court running and start making some three pointers! Please read all the information in this packet thoroughly. Feel free to call Traci at 773-0539 if you have any further questions.

### Enclosed in packet:

1. A league information sheet
2. A roster that needs to be filled out **completely** before it is returned to the Parks and Recreation Office. Each player must sign the roster with the wavier on the bottom in order to play.
3. Completed packets must be received no later than the deadline stated on the league information sheet. See league information sheet for game starting dates.

### **TEAMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE DEADLINE ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS!!!**

When the roster has been completed, submit your packet to the Parks & Recreation Office along with your team fee. **We will ONLY accept teams submitting the entire package complete with all required fees.** Partial payments and incomplete rosters will NOT be accepted. Completed packets must be received by the advertised registration deadline to assure your team's participation. Please remember that all players must be 18 years of age or older & NOT playing school ball during the scheduled league time. No one will be allowed to play if they have not signed the roster form or if they are an additional player (over your 8 registered players), in that case they must pay their add on fee & sign roster. No registrations will be taken at the gym. All registration must be done at the Parks & Recreation Office at (408 Spokane St., City Hall Building) or online at [www.postfallsidaho.org](http://www.postfallsidaho.org). **Please don't forget everyone playing must have the same color jersey with a number on it.** Thank you for all your help & cooperation.

### REMINDERS:

- If a team is ahead by 20 points or more at halftime or anytime in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half the lead becomes 20 points, the clock will begin as a running clock (at the current time of play, if lead occurs during play in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half) or if the lead is set in the first half a 16 minute running clock will begin then, except for time outs. If a team can get the deficit down to 10 points, then the clock will be stopped as normal.
- Game time is forfeit time! NO GRACE PERIOD!
- Reminder, you may only be registered for and/or play on one team in the league.
- No dunking or Cussing!
- Young kids must be supervised in the bleachers by an adult.

**DIVISION:** Lower C and Upper C Divisions are being offered.  
Please specify 1<sup>st</sup> choice on Roster Sheet.  
If there are not enough teams for the Lower C Division, we will have a combined Upper C Division. **There will be a 12-team cap in each division.**

**TIMES:** Games will start at approximately 6:30pm on Tuesdays & Thursdays and will be held at Ponderosa Elementary School (2800 Ponderosa Blvd.) or Mullan Trail Elementary School (11<sup>th</sup> & Compton).

**A game may begin at 9:00pm if necessary for scheduling purposes.**

# POST FALLS MEN'S BASKETBALL RULES

## 1. TEAMS AND PLAYERS:

- a. Teams must have a minimum of eight (8) players to be admitted into the league. Players must be a minimum of **18 years old, a senior in high school & not** playing school ball during the scheduled league time.
- b. Names of team members must be submitted to the Parks & Recreation Department office during the registration period only. Additional players picked up after league play opens must be registered in the Recreation Department office before 5:00 p.m. on the day they first play. Violation of this rule is cause for forfeit. (**NOTE: No registrations will be taken in the gym.**) No new players will be accepted after 5 games have been played by the team you are wishing to register with.
- c. Players are now eligible to play in the Cd'A and Post Falls men's basketball leagues with only one guideline and that is: Players that played in Cd'A in the upper "C" league must play in the upper "C" league in Post Falls. Players that played in the lower "C" league in Cd'A can play in either "C" league in Post Falls. Players that played in any league higher than "C" league will not be eligible. NOTE: If you are playing in the lower "C" league, you can have (1) player that played on an upper "C" league team in Cd'A or Post Falls. The Post Falls Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to determine if a player's level of play is in accordance with our league policies.
- d. **All teams must wear reversible jerseys with printed numbers.**
- e. Two (2), 16-minute periods will constitute a game.  
**\*If a team is ahead by 20 points or more at halftime or anytime in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half the lead becomes 20 points, the clock will begin as a running clock (at the current time of play, if lead occurs during play in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half) or if the lead is set in the first half a 16 minute running clock will begin then except for time outs. If a team can get the deficit down to 10 points, then the clock will be stopped as normal.**

## 2. RULES: Official Idaho State High School Basketball Rules shall govern league games in conjunction with supplemental league rules in regards to forfeited games.

- a. **GAME TIME is forfeit time!**  
**NO GRACE PERIOD!**
- b. Teams will forfeit if rules set forth by the Parks & Recreation Department are violated.
- c. If a player fails to have registration card and fee turned into the Parks & Recreation Department office prior to playing in his first game, the result will be a forfeiture.
- d. People not competing in games will not be allowed on game floor, permitted to bounce balls or shoot on side baskets at any time. Kids will be required to be seated on bleachers in gymnasiums only. Problems resulting from not following these rules will constitute a warning followed by a team technical foul.
- e. Food & drink of any kind **is not** allowed in any Post Falls gyms. Exception: players are allowed water or a sports drinks.
- f. Other cases subject to forfeit as stated in Official Rules.
- g. **Dunking in warm-ups or half time will result in a technical foul at a minimum & player could sit out for the rest of the game or longer.**
- h. **Dunking in any game will result in a technical foul at a minimum, & player could sit out for the rest of the game or longer. Team could forfeit game.**  
**If damage is done to rim, supports, or the backboards and the game cannot be finished, the dunking team will automatically forfeit that game regardless of score.**

- i. Time-out(s): Two time-outs per half, with NO carry over.
- j. Overtime is three minutes, with each team getting one time-out.

3. **TRANSFERS AND RELEASES:**

- a. A player may not transfer from one team to another after his original team has played two (2) league games. No player is allowed to play for or register for more than one team.
- b. Once a player participates with a team in a league game, he establishes a position on that team and becomes subject to rules of transfer and release.

4. **GAMES AND SCHEDULES:**

- a. Schedules will be made by the Post Falls Park & Recreation Department in accordance with team registration in each league.
- b. No games will be cancelled or postponed unless the gym is not available and the game is cancelled by the Post Falls Park & Recreation Department. **No exceptions!!**

5. **OFFICIALS:**

- a. Officials will be furnished by the Post Falls Park & Recreation Department

6. **PENALTIES:**

- a. Any player receiving a technical foul for unsportsmanlike conduct and/or an intentional foul will be removed from the game for five (5) minutes. Any combination of technical fouls or intentional fouls that add up to two (2) will be cause for expulsion from that game and shall be suspended from league play for a minimum of one (1) game. NOTE: Technical fouls also count as a personal foul.
- b. If any league team, as a group, displays continuous unsportsmanlike play and/or conduct and receives three (3) technical fouls in one game, it shall forfeit that game and is liable for suspension from the league. Depending upon the decision of the Parks & Recreation Department, and all fees paid by sponsors & players will be lost.
- c. Any player expelled from any league game for any reason other than five (5) personal fouls shall automatically be suspended for one (1) game and placed on probation for the remainder of the season. Second offense shall result in a suspension for the remainder of the season or longer if deemed necessary.
- d. Any player using abusive language or obscene gestures toward any official, staff member, player or spectator will automatically be suspended. Duration would be up to the discretion of the Parks & Recreation Department.
