White craft glue

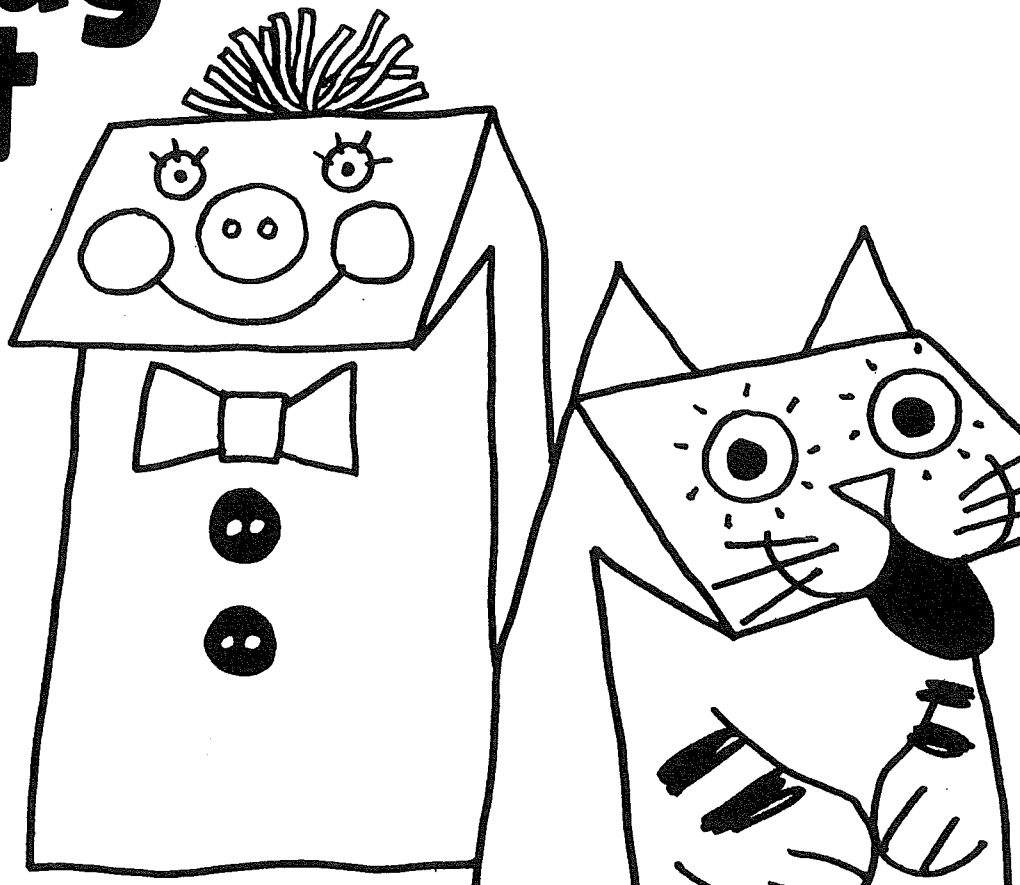
Small brown paper bag

Construction paper

Yarn

Child safety scissors

Markers

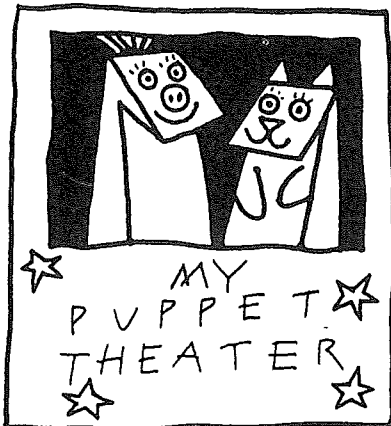




HERE'S WHAT YOU DO

- 1 Draw the puppet's eyes, nose, and mouth onto the bottom flap of the paper bag.
- 2 Glue on yarn for the puppet's hair.
- 3 Put a hand inside the bag to move the puppet's mouth.
- 4 Use scissors to cut out things such as bow ties and buttons from the construction paper. Glue them onto the bag for puppet's costume.

MORE ART FUN!



- ★ Ask a grown-up to use sharp scissors or utility knife to cut away the entire lid of a cardboard box for rear of a stage. Cut a large opening in the bottom of the box for the stage. Paint the box with poster paint. Allow it to dry completely; then place it on a table for a puppet show.
- ★ Talk about the feelings of **happy** and **sad**. How can you tell when someone feels happy or sad? How can you show if your puppet feels happy or sad?
