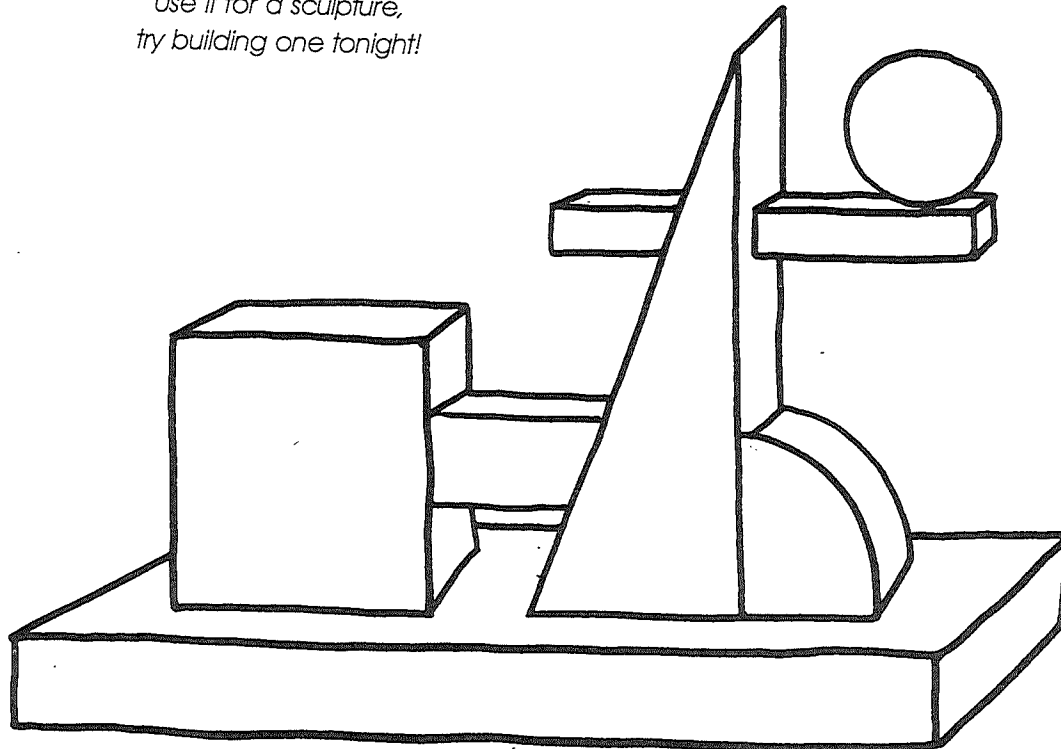


Recycle Sculpture

Take packing from a box
— avoid a landfill site —
Use it for a sculpture,
try building one tonight!



HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED

Styrofoam blocks, packing
popcorn, packing noodles

*Dull knife

Toothpicks

HERE'S WHAT YOU DO

- 1 Use the dull knife to cut styrofoam blocks into a variety of shapes and sizes. Save a flat piece for sculpture's base.
- 2 Use toothpicks to attach the blocks and other found materials to each other for a sculpture; then press into styrofoam base.

MORE ART FUN!

- ★ Use materials such as twigs, pipe cleaners, scraps of wood, empty thread spools, drinking straws, and spaghetti as part of your recycle sculpture.
- ★ Make an Art Box. Paint a large cardboard box or cover one in old wallpaper. Write **Art Box** in big letters. Collect all sorts of objects — rinsed-off foil, fabric scraps, wallpaper samples, paper towel rolls, thread spools, buttons, yarn, rinsed yogurt containers, and more. Use an egg carton to collect small things like glitter, sequins, seeds, and pebbles. You'll have lots to work with when you need supplies or inspiration. (For more items to collect, see page 152.)
