

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FOX TRAILERS ZONE TEXT AMENDMENT
(TITLE 18)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of Post Falls will hold a public hearing at City Hall, 408 Spokane Street, on the 18th of December, 2018 at 6:00 p.m., on a request to amend a portion of Section 18 of the PFMC (18.36.040D) that pertains to “Signs Authorized without a Sign Permit – Flags”. The original proposal was to allow flags to be erected as tall and/or as large as possible, such that they are engineered accordingly and do not pose a threat to the public health, safety and or welfare within the City of Post Falls. On the 13th of November, 2018 the Planning and Zoning Commission after receiving testimony, recommended an alternative to City Council that would allow an increase in flag size along HWY 41, I-90, and Pleasantview Rd. for non-residential zones.

Persons are encouraged to submit any and all written comments by **December 11, 2018** in order to be included in the Staff Report. If you plan to present documents, maps, or a presentation at the hearing, you must contact us by **December 11, 2018** for the “Presentation Guidelines”.*

*For comments after **December 11, 2018** oral and written testimony may be provided during the public hearing and submitted into the record. Testimony may be limited to 4 minutes per person.*
