Residents Encouraged to Take Survey on Parks & Recreation

Post Falls residents will have an opportunity to help shape the future of parks and recreation in Post Falls by taking a survey this month. A random sampling of 4,500 households have been mailed a survey. Their responses will provide statically valid results. Additionally, an online survey will be available for all residents, beginning August 14th through August 28th. The link to the survey is www.postfallsparks.org/open.

The City commissioned a parks and recreation community survey to help update and shape the City's Parks and Recreation Master Plan. Community input is an important part of this process and helps the City to tailor the plan to reflect the community's desires and needs.

The results of this survey will provide critical information in determining community values, satisfaction levels, needs and priorities, and demographics for the City's long-term planning efforts. Questions will be asked about what types of programs,

facilities, and services residents want in their parks and recreation system and where priorities should be placed.

The results of the surveys will be presented the week of September 17 -20 during Findings & Vision Workshops as part of the Parks & Recreation Master Plan process. Meeting times and locations will be announced later.
