### **Post Falls Festival Cancelled**

The Post Falls Festival, scheduled for July 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>, has been cancelled. The City of Post Falls cancelled the annual festival due to concerns regarding the escalation of coronavirus cases in north Idaho and the surrounding area.

The decision was made after discussions with representatives from the Panhandle Health District. The City also consulted with other cities and area event providers who have also recently cancelled events at the recommendation of Panhandle Health. Although cancelling the event was a difficult decision, it is important to take precautions to lessen the risk for the community, as public health and safety is the highest priority.

City staff has been working for several months changing and adapting this event in an effort to create a safe environment while still providing an enjoyable event. Unfortunately, the continued rise in coronavirus cases in our area necessitated the cancellation of the Festival.

We appreciate our citizens' continued support of our programs and the Post Falls Festival will be back next year stronger than ever.
