On May 23<sup>rd</sup>, the City of Post Falls Police Department experienced a data security event causing disruption to certain internal Department systems including digital media, email and others. At no point was the ability of the Police Department to provide police protection to the community compromised. The 911 system is fully functional along with our dispatch and patrol systems. We are working around the clock with assistance from computer forensic specialists to investigate the root cause of this event and to bring the internal systems back online in a safe and secure manner. To date, no sensitive data appears to be compromised. We have substantial resources dedicated to this process. If you have questions regarding this event, please refer your inquiry to Chief of Police, Pat Knight so that we can ensure you receive an accurate and timely response. As this event is part of a police investigation, the information that we are allowed to release is limited. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this time. We are dedicated to serving our community and will provide updates when available.

As always, the City of Post Falls Police Department stands ready to protect and serve the citizens of Post Falls.
